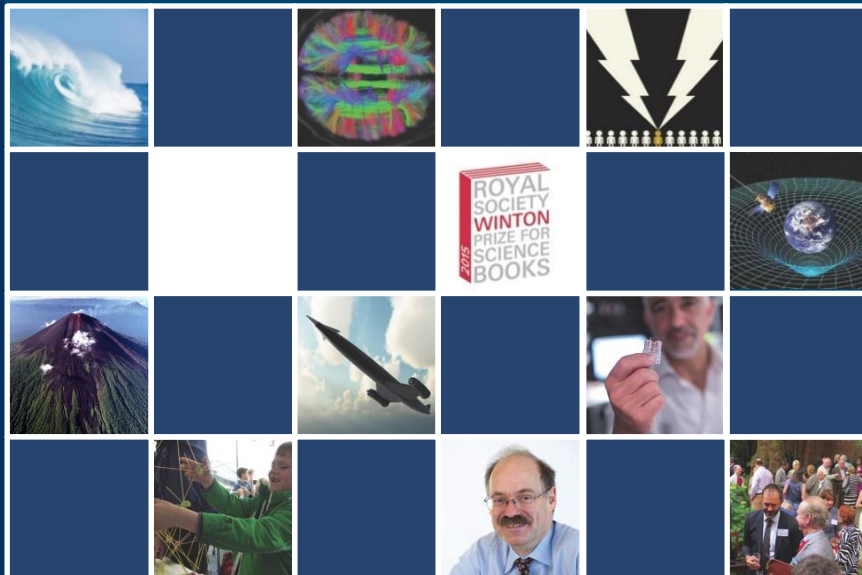

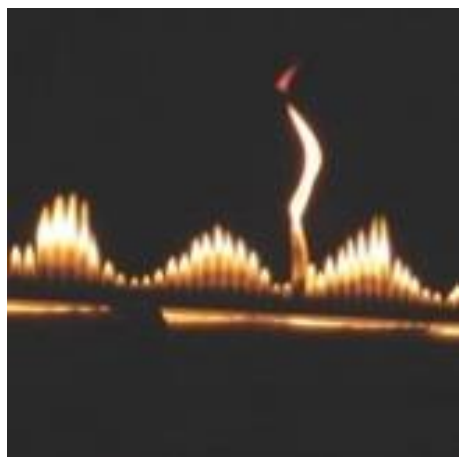
Quantum mechanics in a nutshell
